THE BOYS

We pride ourselves on being a "boy run" troop, which means that most of the activities are planned and carried out by the boys. This may not always be the fastest or easiest way to get things done, but it teaches the boys responsibility and gives them the satisfaction of a job well done.

Each Scout advances at his own pace as part of the learning experience. Older scouts mentor the younger ones, teaching leadership and reinforcing what has been learned. Over 110 scouts have achieved eagle rank since the troops inception.

THE LEADERS

Our team of adult leaders are always ready to encourage the boys, help them examine what they did or didn't do right so that they can improve. We are there to insure the safety of the boys and to provide guidance as they develop in the three aims of Scouting: to build character, to foster citizenship, and to develop fitness.

All parents are expected to provide assistance to the troop. They can be part of the troop committee or become a uniformed assistant Scoutmaster. Parents are also encouraged to become registered Merit Badge Counselors to share with the boys what they have learned through their profession or hobbies.
