Featured 2021 Eagle Scout Project

The **National Eagle Scout Service Project of the Year** was awarded to Apará Sai Jella from Troop 36(G) in Danville. She is the first female Eagle Scout to be bestowed with the **Adams Award**.

Apará's project provides residents at a women's rehabilitation center in Oakland a place to meditate and find peace. It also provides an area to spend time with their children and watch them play. Apará and her team of volunteers built a playground, painted a mural, constructed benches and painted a hopscotch and racetrack games.

The residents were impressed by the Apará's leadership and work. "They came outside and clapped for us; they loved it" Apará says.
